- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- SECTION 1. The following section shall be codified as 5
- Section 97-37-39, Mississippi Code of 1972: 6
- 7 97-37-39. (1) Any person who manufactures, possesses, or
- uses a machine gun conversion device shall be guilty of a felony. 8
- 9 For purposes of this act, the term "machine gun conversion" means
- and includes devices that convert ordinary semiautomatic firearms 10
- 11 into fully automatic machine guns, which may include, but shall
- 12 not be limited to "Glock switches" or "auto-sears".
- Any person convicted of a first offense in violation of 13
- 14 this act shall be guilty of a felony, and shall be sentenced to
- 15 imprisonment for a term of not more than ten (10) years, fined not
- 16 more than Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00), or both.
- A person convicted of a second or subsequent offense 17
- 18 shall be charged with a felony under this act and shall be

- 19 sentenced to imprisonment for a term of not more than fifteen (15)
- 20 years, fined not more than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00), or
- 21 both.
- 22 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 23 and after July 1, 2024.
