HOUSE BILL NO. 1024

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 99-19-77, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES TO RECOVER 3 INVESTIGATIVE COSTS FROM A DEFENDANT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 99-19-77, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 5 amended as follows: 6 99-19-77. In addition to any criminal penalties or fines, 7 the court may impose an assessment against a defendant convicted 8 9 of a felony violation, or a Class I violation that is punishable as provided in Section 49-7-141, investigated by the Office of the 10 11 Attorney General, the district attorneys, sheriffs, the Mississippi Bureau of Investigation, the Mississippi Department of 12 13 Human Services, Office of Inspector General, Fraud Investigative 14 Unit, Mississippi Bureau of Narcotics, the Mississippi Agricultural and Livestock Theft Bureau, the Mississippi 15 Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks and municipal police 16 departments which may cover all reasonable costs of the 17 18 investigation. Costs are to be paid to the appropriate

No. 1024 G1/2 24/HR31/R1625 PAGE 1 (GT\JAB) 19 governmental entity incurring the particular item of cost and 20 include, but are not limited to, the cost of investigators, 21 service of process, court reporters, expert witnesses and 22 attorney's fees, and transportation costs expended by the 23 governmental entity in the investigation of such case, and must be 24 used to augment the governmental entity's existing budget and not 25 to supplant it.

26 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 27 and after July 1, 2024.
