HOUSE BILL NO. 1047

- AN ACT TO DECLARE THE FUNDAMENTAL RIGHTS OF PARENTS TO DIRECT THE UPBRINGING OF THEIR CHILDREN; TO PROHIBIT ANY AGENCY OF THIS STATE FROM INFRINGING ON THE FUNDAMENTAL RIGHTS OF PARENTS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** The Legislature of Mississippi declares the
- 7 following:
- 8 (a) The United States Supreme Court has recognized that
- 9 parents have a fundamental right to direct the upbringing of their
- 10 children.
- 11 (b) The liberty protected by the due process clause
- 12 includes the fundamental right of parents to direct the education,
- 13 upbringing, care and control of their children.
- 14 **SECTION 2.** (1) The liberty interest of a parent in the
- 15 nurture, education, care, custody and control of the parent's
- 16 child is a fundamental right.
- 17 (2) No agency or officer of this state nor any agency or
- 18 officer of any subdivision of this state shall infringe

19 fundamental parental rights except as provided by law narrowly

- 20 tailored to meet a compelling governmental interest by the least
- 21 restrictive means.
- 22 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 23 and after July 1, 2024.
