1 2 3 4	AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 23-15-907, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO DEFINE "CAREGIVER", "FAMILY MEMBER" AND "HOUSEHOLD MEMBER" FOR THE PURPOSES OF THE BALLOT HARVESTING LAW; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
6	SECTION 1. Section 23-15-907, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
7	amended as follows:
8	23-15-907. (1) For purposes of this section, the following
9	words shall have the meanings as defined herein unless the context
10	clearly indicates otherwise:
11	(a) "Caregiver" means an individual who provides
12	medical, health care assistance or other assistance to the person
13	to whom the ballot was mailed in a residence, hospital, long term
14	care facility, nursing home, hospice facility, assisted living
15	center, assisted living facility, assisted living home,
16	residential care institution, adult day health care facility,
17	adult foster care home or other similar facility or institution.

18 "Family member" means an individual who is related (b) 19 by blood, marriage, adoption or legal guardianship to the person 20 to whom the ballot was mailed. 21 (c) "Household member" means an individual who resides 22 at the same residence as the person to whom the ballot was mailed. 23 ( \* \* \*2) A person shall not knowingly collect and transmit 24 a ballot that was mailed to another person, except as follows: An election official while engaged in official 25 (a) 26 duties as authorized by law. 27 (b) An employee of the United States Postal Service 28 while engaged in official duties as authorized by law. 29 Any other individual who is allowed by federal law (C) 30 to collect and transmit United States mail while engaged in 31 official duties as authorized by law. 32 A family member, household member, or caregiver of (d) 33 the person to whom the ballot was mailed. 34 A common carrier that transports goods from one (e) place to another for a fee. No parcel shall contain more than a 35 36 single ballot. 37 ( \* \* \*3) Any violation of this section shall be subject to 38 the penalties of Section 97-13-37. 39 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2024. 40
