## HOUSE BILL NO. 1121

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 7-1-1 AND 25-1-3, MISSISSIPPI CODE
- 2 OF 1972, TO MAKE MINOR, NONSUBSTANTIVE CHANGES THAT CONFORM
- 3 CHANGES MADE IN HOUSE BILL NO. 1276, 2023 REGULAR SESSION; AND FOR
- 4 RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** Section 7-1-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 7-1-1. When it shall be ascertained who is chosen Governor,
- 9 he shall be installed and the oath of office administered to him
- 10 by one (1) of the judges of the Supreme Court or, in their
- 11 absence, by the presiding officer of one (1) of the two (2) houses
- 12 of the Legislature, in the presence of the two (2) houses. The
- 13 time of such installation shall be at noon on the \* \*  $\star$
- 14 Tuesday \* \* \* next after the \* \* \* first day of the legislative
- 15 session, or as soon thereafter as practicable, unless a different
- 16 time be fixed by a concurrent resolution of the two (2) houses.
- SECTION 2. Section 25-1-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 18 amended as follows:

- 19 25-1-3. The term of office of all state officers elected at
- 20 a general election for that purpose, except the Governor, shall
- 21 commence on the Thursday next after \* \* \* the first day of the
- 22 legislative session.
- 23 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 24 and after July 1, 2024.
