HOUSE BILL NO. 1194

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 37-15-6, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO AUTHORIZE THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO REPORT AGGREGATE DATA CONCERNING PUBLIC SCHOOL EXPULSIONS WHICH DOES NOT DISCLOSE STUDENTS' PERSONALLY IDENTIFIABLE INFORMATION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 **SECTION 1.** Section 37-15-6, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 8 amended as follows:
- 9 37-15-6. For the purpose of providing notice to public and
- 10 private school officials, both within and outside the boundaries
- 11 of the state, of the expulsion of any public school student, the
- 12 State Department of Education may develop a central reporting
- 13 system for maintaining information concerning each expulsion from
- 14 a public school. In establishing and maintaining the reporting
- 15 system, the department may require each school district and
- 16 charter school to report, within a certain period of time after an
- 17 expulsion, as established by the department, information such as
- 18 the following:
- 19 (a) The name of the student expelled;

20	d)) The	date the student was expelled;
21	(c) The	age of the student at the time of the
22	expulsion;		
23	(d) The	school from which the student was expelled;
24	(e) The	reason for the expulsion, including a detailed
25	description	of the	student's act or acts;
26	(f) The	duration of the period of expulsion, if not
27	indefinite; and		
28	(g) Any	other information that the department deems
29	necessary fo	r schoo	ol officials in a public or private school,
30	where a stud	ent is	seeking enrollment, to determine whether or not
31	a student sh	ould be	e denied enrollment based upon a previous
32	expulsion.		
33	Any inf	ormatio	on maintained by the department under the
34	authority of	this s	ection shall be strictly confidential. The
35	information shall be available to school officials at a public or		
36	private school only upon their request and only when a student		
37	seeks enrollment or admission to that school. In no case shall		
38	the informat	ion be	available to the general public; however,
39	aggregate re	porting	by the department which does not disclose any
40	personally i	dentifi	able information is permitted.
