HOUSE BILL NO. 1355

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 25-9-147, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO REQUIRE THE STATE PERSONNEL BOARD TO WORK WITH THE LEGISLATIVE 3 BUDGET OFFICE TO DEVELOP SALARY FUNDING LEVELS FOR EACH STATE 4 AGENCY UNDER THE PURVIEW OF THE STATE PERSONNEL BOARD; TO PROVIDE 5 THAT THE LEGISLATIVE BUDGET OFFICE SHALL PROVIDE A RECONCILIATION 6 OF SALARY FUNDING LEVELS FOR EACH FISCAL YEAR TO THE STATE 7 PERSONNEL BOARD WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER THE DATE OF SINE DIE 8 ADJOURNMENT OF THE REGULAR LEGISLATIVE SESSION; AND FOR RELATED 9 PURPOSES.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

11 SECTION 1. Section 25-9-147, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

12 amended as follows:

25-9-147. (1) The State Personnel Board shall review on an 13 14 annual basis the variable compensation plan adopted by the Legislature at the regular session of 1981 and subsequently 15 implemented by the State Personnel Board. Each state department 16 17 or agency subject to the variable compensation plan shall prepare an annual written report under the direction of the head of that 18 19 department or agency outlining the impact which the plan has had 20 on that department or agency during the preceding fiscal year. 21 Such department or agency report shall be submitted to the State

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22 Personnel Board and shall become a part of the board's annual 23 review of the variable compensation plan. After conducting its annual review of the plan and studying the report of each 24 25 department or agency, the State Personnel Board shall prepare a 26 written legislative report, to be submitted to the members of the 27 Mississippi Legislature prior to January 1 of each year. This written report shall accurately reflect the effect of the variable 28 29 compensation plan on the various departments or agencies subject 30 to the plan. * * * The plan shall be named the "Colonel Guy 31 Groff/Neville Kenning Variable Compensation Plan."

32 The State Personnel Board shall work with the (2) (a) 33 Legislative Budget Office to develop salary funding levels for 34 each state agency under the purview of the State Personnel Board. 35 The salary funding level will be developed for each fiscal year 36 with information provided by the State Personnel Board and the 37 state agency. The Legislative Budget Office shall provide a 38 reconciliation of salary funding levels for each fiscal year to 39 the State Personnel Board within thirty (30) days after the date 40 of sine die adjournment of the regular legislative session. The 41 State Personnel Board will then provide the salary funding levels 42 to all agencies under their purview. 43 The agency shall ensure that all personal services (b)

44 actions and payroll will not exceed the salary funding levels

45 provided by the State Personnel Board. The State Personnel Board

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46 shall monitor the impact of personal services actions to ensure 47 their projected cost will not exceed the salary funding levels. If an agency determines that the funding level is 48 (C) 49 insufficient, the agency shall contact the State Personnel Board, 50 the Legislative Budget Office and the State Fiscal Officer. The 51 State Personnel Board shall have the authority to approve or deny 52 any requests for revision of the salary funding levels, the State 53 Fiscal Officer shall certify that funds are available for that 54 purpose. The State Personnel Board shall provide notification of 55 the approval or denial, and justification for the approval or 56 denial shall be sent to the Chairmen of House and Senate 57 Appropriations and the Legislative Budget Office. 58 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

59 and after its passage.
