4	SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section
5	99-5-41, Mississippi Code of 1972:
6	99-5-41. A bail bond and the obligation thereunder is
7	discharged and becomes null and void when:
8	(a) The defendant is found guilty and sentence is
9	pronounced;
10	(b) The charge is dismissed or nolle prosequi;
11	(c) The charge is retired or remanded to the files;
12	(d) The defendant is surrendered by a bail agent in
13	open court or to the sheriff or chief of police or respective
14	jailer of the proper jurisdiction or a verbal or written,
15	including electronic detention, notice of surrender is delivered
16	thereto as required in Section 99-5-27; or
17	(e) The defendant is sentenced to nonadjudication, an
18	alternative sentence, or an intervention court program.
