HOUSE BILL NO. 1441

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 97-37-37, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO INCREASE TERM OF IMPRISONMENT FOR USE OF A SEMI-AUTOMATIC 3 FIREARM DURING THE COMMISSION OF A FELONY; AND FOR RELATED 4 PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. Section 97-37-37, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 amended as follows:

8 97-37-37. (1) Except to the extent that a greater minimum 9 sentence is otherwise provided by any other provision of law, any 10 person who uses or displays a firearm during the commission of any 11 felony shall, in addition to the punishment provided for such 12 felony, be sentenced to an additional term of imprisonment in the 13 custody of the Department of Corrections of five (5) years, which 14 sentence shall not be reduced or suspended.

(2) Except to the extent that a greater minimum sentence is 15 otherwise provided by any other provision of law, any convicted 16 17 felon who uses or displays a firearm during the commission of any felony shall, in addition to the punishment provided for such 18 felony, be sentenced to an additional term of imprisonment in the 19 H. 20 custody of the Department of Corrections of ten (10) years, to run 21 consecutively, not concurrently, which sentence shall not be 22 reduced or suspended.

23 (3) Except to the extent that a greater minimum sentence is 24 otherwise provided by any other provision of law, any person who 25 uses or displays a semi-automatic or automatic firearm capable of 26 accepting a large capacity magazine during the commission of a 27 felony shall be, in additon to punishment provided for such felony 28 and the enhancements listed in subsections (1) and (2) of this 29 section, sentenced to an additional term of imprisonment in the 30 custody of the Department of Corrections which shall run 31 consecutively, not concurrently, and shall not be reduced or 32 suspended. For purposes of this subsection, the term 33 "semi-automatic or automatic firearm capable of accepting a large 34 capacity magazine" means a firearm that has a magazine device that 35 can accept more than fifteen (15) rounds of ammunition; or a 36 magazine or similar device that could accept more than fifteen (15) rounds of ammunition and the person was in close proximity to 37 38 the firearm during the commission of a crime. 39 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

40 and after July 1, 2024.
