- SECTION 1. Section 97-37-37, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 5

- 97-37-37. (1) Except to the extent that a greater minimum 7
- sentence is otherwise provided by any other provision of law, any 8
- 9 person who uses or displays a firearm during the commission of any
- felony that is not defined as a crime of violence in Section 10
- 97-3-2 shall, in addition to the punishment provided for such 11
- felony, be sentenced to an additional term of imprisonment in the 12
- custody of the Department of Corrections of five (5) years $\star \star \star$. 13
- 14 (2) Except to the extent that a greater minimum sentence is
- otherwise provided by any other provision of law, any convicted 15
- felon who uses or displays a firearm during the commission of any 16
- felony that is defined as a crime of violence in Section 97-3-2 17
- shall, in addition to the punishment provided for such felony, be 18

- 19 sentenced to an additional term of imprisonment in the custody of
- 20 the Department of Corrections of $\frac{* * *}{}$ twenty (20) years, to run
- 21 consecutively, not concurrently, which sentence shall not be
- 22 reduced or suspended.
