## HOUSE BILL NO. 1444

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 45-1-19, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 CLARIFY THE AUTHORITY OF THE CAPITOL POLICE TO ENFORCE VIOLATION 3 OF ANY MUNICIPAL CODE OR MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE CREATED BY THE CITY OF JACKSON; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. Section 45-1-19, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 7 amended as follows: 45-1-19. (1) The Department of Public Safety, through the 8 9 Office of Capitol Police, shall have jurisdiction relative to the 10 enforcement of all laws of the State of Mississippi on the properties, from curb to curb, including adjoining streets, 11 12 sidewalks and leased parking lots within the Capitol Complex, set forth in Section 29-5-2, the Governor's mansion, the Supreme Court 13 14 Building, the Mississippi Department of Transportation Building and the Public Employees' Retirement System Building, and any 15 property purchased, constructed or otherwise acquired by the State 16 17 of Mississippi for conducting state business and not specifically under the supervision and care by any other state entity, but 18 19 which is reasonably assumed the Department of Public Safety would H. - 20 be responsible for such. The Department of Public Safety shall,
- 21 through any person or persons appointed by the commissioner, make
- 22 arrests for any violation of any law of the State of Mississippi
- 23 on the grounds of or within those properties. The Department of
- 24 Public Safety shall, in addition, enforce the provisions of this
- 25 section and Sections 29-5-57 through 29-5-67, 29-5-73 through
- 26 29-5-75, and 29-5-81 through 29-5-95, and prescribe such rules and
- 27 regulations as are necessary therefor. The powers and duties
- 28 related to the administration of Sections 29-5-57 through 29-5-67,
- 29 29-5-73 through 29-5-75, and 29-5-81 through 29-5-95 shall remain
- 30 with the Department of Finance and Administration.
- 31 (2) Subject to the approval of the Board of Trustees of
- 32 State Institutions of Higher Learning, the Board of Trustees and
- 33 the Department of Public Safety shall be authorized to enter into
- 34 a contract for the Department of Public Safety to supply the
- 35 security personnel with jurisdiction to enforce all laws of the
- 36 State of Mississippi on the property of the Board of Trustees
- 37 located at the corner of Ridgewood Road and Lakeland Drive in the
- 38 City of Jackson.
- 39 (3) The Department of Public Safety and the Department of
- 40 Agriculture are authorized to enter into a contract for the
- 41 Department of Public Safety to have jurisdiction and enforce all
- 42 laws of the State of Mississippi on the property of the Department
- 43 of Agriculture located at 121 North Jefferson Street and the new
- 44 Farmers Market Building located at the corner of High and

- 45 Jefferson Streets in the City of Jackson, Hinds County,
- 46 Mississippi. It is the intent of the Legislature that the
- 47 Department of Public Safety will not post any security personnel
- 48 at such buildings, but will provide regular vehicle patrols and
- 49 responses to security system alarms.
- 50 (4) The Department of Public Safety and the Department of
- 51 Agriculture are authorized to enter into a contract for the
- 52 Department of Public Safety to have jurisdiction and enforce all
- 53 laws of the State of Mississippi on the property of the Department
- of Agriculture known as the "Mississippi State Fairgrounds
- 55 Complex" and any and all of its outlying buildings and property.
- 56 The Department of Public Safety and the Department of Agriculture
- 57 are authorized to enter into a contract for the Department of
- 58 Public Safety to supply the security personnel to the Department
- 59 of Agriculture with jurisdiction to enforce all laws of the State
- of Mississippi on this property and any and all buildings on this
- 61 property. The Department of Public Safety is authorized to charge
- 62 the Department of Agriculture a fee for security services provided
- 63 for special events at the Mississippi State Fairgrounds Complex.
- 64 The fee charged will be commensurate with the cost associated with
- 65 the Department of Public Safety providing those services.
- 66 (5) The Department of Public Safety and the Department of
- 67 Revenue are authorized to enter into a contract for the Department
- 68 of Public Safety to supply the security personnel with
- 69 jurisdiction to enforce all laws of the State of Mississippi at

- 70 the Alcoholic Beverage Control facility and the Department of
- 71 Revenue main office.
- 72 (6) (a) The Department of Public Safety shall have primary
- 73 jurisdiction relative to any other state or municipal law
- 74 enforcement agency to enforce all laws of the State of Mississippi
- 75 within the boundaries of the Capitol Complex Improvement District
- 76 created in Section 29-5-203; such enforcement shall be its primary
- 77 function. The Department of Public Safety may, through any person
- 78 or persons appointed by the Department of Public Safety, make
- 79 arrests for any violation of any law of the State of Mississippi
- 80 and \* \* \* any violation of the municipal code and/or ordinance of
- 81 the City of Jackson which occurs within the boundaries of the
- 82 district and within the boundaries of the City of Jackson. The
- 83 Department of Public Safety may choose to present cases to either
- 84 the District Attorney or the prosecuting attorneys designated by
- 85 the Attorney General for prosecution of any violation of law that
- 86 accrues or occurs, in whole or in part, within the boundaries
- 87 established by Section 29-5-203. The jurisdiction of the
- 88 Department of Public Safety granted under this subsection (6)
- 89 shall be concurrent with the jurisdiction of the City of Jackson,
- 90 Mississippi, and that of Hinds County, Mississippi within the
- 91 boundaries of the Capitol Complex Improvement District created in
- 92 Section 29-5-203. At any time and/or during any event
- 93 necessitating the coordination of and/or utilization at multiple
- 94 jurisdictions, as determined by the Chief of Capitol Police or the

- 95 Commissioner of the Department of Public Safety shall be the lead
- 96 agency when the event occurs on property as defined herein that is
- 97 owned or leased by the state as provided in subsection (1) of this
- 98 section. The jurisdiction and authority of the Department of
- 99 Public Safety under this subsection (6) shall be in addition to
- 100 any other jurisdiction and authority provided to the department
- 101 under this section or any other law.
- 102 (b) The Department of Public Safety shall have
- 103 jurisdiction relative to the enforcement of all laws of the State
- 104 of Mississippi within the boundaries of the City of Jackson,
- 105 Mississippi. The Department of Public Safety may, through any
- 106 person or persons appointed by the Department of Public Safety,
- 107 make arrests for any violation of any law of the State of
- 108 Mississippi which occurs within the boundaries of the City of
- 109 Jackson. The jurisdiction of the Department of Public Safety
- 110 granted under this paragraph (b) shall not be primary and shall be
- 111 concurrent with the jurisdiction of the City of Jackson,
- 112 Mississippi, and that of Hinds County, Mississippi.
- 113 (c) Written approval from the Chief of the Capitol
- 114 Police or the Commissioner of the Department of Public Safety
- 115 shall be required before any event occurs which will take place on
- 116 any street or sidewalk immediately adjacent to any building or
- 117 property owned or occupied by any official, agency, board,
- 118 commission, office or other entity of the State of Mississippi, or
- 119 which can reasonably be expected to block, impede or otherwise

- 121 Public Safety shall promulgate rules and regulations to effectuate
- 122 the provisions of this paragraph (c).
- 123 (d) The Chief of the Capitol Police and/or the
- 124 Commissioner of the Department of Public Safety, the Chief of the
- 125 Jackson Police Department, and the Sheriff of Hinds County shall
- 126 hold a regular meeting within the boundaries of the Capitol
- 127 Complex Improvement District to address the concerns of the
- 128 public. Each meeting shall be called by the Chief of the Capitol
- 129 Police; and the first meeting shall be called by October 15, 2023.
- 130 (7) The Department of Public Safety is authorized to enter
- into a contract with any county for the county to take custody of
- 132 the misdemeanor offenders arrested under the authority granted
- 133 under this section.
- 134 (8) All accrued personal leave earned pursuant to Section
- 135 25-3-93, accrued major medical leave earned pursuant to Section
- 136 25-3-95, accrued state compensatory leave earned pursuant to
- 137 Section 25-3-92, and compensatory leave earned pursuant to the
- 138 Fair Labor Standards Act (FLSA) shall transfer from the Department
- 139 of Finance and Administration to the Department of Public Safety
- 140 for all employees transferred under this section.
- 141 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 142 and after July 1, 2024.
