- (b) Who is serving on probation, parole, earned-release 15

19	(c) Detained, arrested or otherwise in custody.
20	(2) It is unlawful for any civilian with supervisory or
21	custodial authority over * * * \underline{a} person to engage in any sexual
22	penetration, as defined in Section 97-3-97, or other sexual act
23	with the * * * person, with the * * * person's consent, who is:
24	(a) Incarcerated at any jail or any state, county or
25	private correctional facility * * *;
26	(b) Who is serving on probation, parole, earned-release
27	supervision, post-release supervision, earned probation, intensive

29	(c) Detained, arrested or otherwise in custody.
30	(3) Any person who violates this section is guilty of a
