HOUSE BILL NO. 1673

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 23-15-851, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT IF A VACANCY OCCURS TWELVE MONTHS BEFORE THE GENERAL ELECTION FOR STATE OFFICERS IS HELD, THE GOVERNOR SHALL NOT ISSUE A WRIT OF ELECTION TO FILL THE VACANCY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 **SECTION 1.** Section 23-15-851, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 8 amended as follows:
- 9 23-15-851. (1) Except as otherwise provided in subsection
- 10 (2) of this section, within thirty (30) days after vacancies occur
- 11 in either house of the Legislature, the Governor shall issue writs
- 12 of election to fill the vacancies on a day specified in the writ
- 13 of election. At least sixty (60) days' notice shall be given of
- 14 the election in each county or part of a county in which the
- 15 election shall be held. The qualifying deadline for the election
- 16 shall be fifty (50) days before the election. Notice of the
- 17 election shall be posted at the courthouse and in each supervisors
- 18 district in the county or part of county in which such election
- 19 shall be held for as near sixty (60) days as may be practicable.

- The election shall be prepared for and held as in the case of a general election.
- 22 (2) If a vacancy occurs \star \star \star twelve (12) months before the
- 23 general election for state officers is held, the Governor * * *
- 24 shall not * * * issue a writ of election to fill the vacancy.
- 25 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 26 and after July 1, 2024.
