1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIKE COUNTY, 2 MISSISSIPPI, TO CONSTRUCT OR ACQUIRE A COUNTY JAIL ANYWHERE 3 WITHIN THE COUNTY; TO ENTER INTO A LEASE AGREEMENT OR 4 LEASE-PURCHASE ARRANGEMENT FOR A TERM NOT TO EXCEED THIRTY YEARS 5 FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FUNDS TO ACQUIRE, MAINTAIN, CONSTRUCT 6 OR EQUIP A PUBLIC BUILDING OR BUILDINGS AND RELATED FACILITIES FOR 7 USE AS A LAW ENFORCEMENT AND PUBLIC SAFETY FACILITY AND/OR COUNTY 8 JAIL FACILITY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 10 **SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 19-7-1, 11 Mississippi Code of 1972, or any other provisions of law to the 12 contrary, the Board of Supervisors of Pike County, Mississippi, is authorized, in its discretion, to construct or acquire a county 13 14 jail anywhere within the county. 15 SECTION 2. The Board of Supervisors of Pike County, 16 Mississippi, in its discretion and pursuant to Section 31-8-1, et seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, is authorized to enter into a 17

exceed thirty (30) years for the purpose of providing funds to

buildings and related facilities for use as a law enforcement and
