HOUSE BILL NO. 1723

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIKE COUNTY, 2 MISSISSIPPI, TO CONSTRUCT OR ACQUIRE A COUNTY JAIL ANYWHERE 3 WITHIN THE COUNTY; TO ENTER INTO A LEASE AGREEMENT OR LEASE-4 PURCHASE ARRANGEMENT FOR A TERM NOT TO EXCEED THIRTY YEARS FOR THE 5 PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FUNDS TO ACQUIRE, MAINTAIN, CONSTRUCT OR 6 EQUIP A PUBLIC BUILDING OR BUILDINGS AND RELATED FACILITIES FOR 7 USE AS A LAW ENFORCEMENT AND PUBLIC SAFETY FACILITY AND/OR COUNTY 8 JAIL FACILITY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

- 10 **SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 19-7-1,
- 11 Mississippi Code of 1972, or any other provisions of law to the
- 12 contrary, the Board of Supervisors of Pike County, Mississippi, is
- authorized, in its discretion, to construct or acquire a county 13
- 14 jail anywhere within the county.
- SECTION 2. The Board of Supervisors of Pike County, 15
- 16 Mississippi, in its discretion and pursuant to Section 13-8-1, et
- seq., Mississippi Code of 1972, is authorized to enter into a 17
- 18 lease agreement or lease-purchase arrangement for a term not to
- 19 exceed thirty (30) years for the purpose of providing funds to
- 20 acquire, maintain, construct, or equip a public building or

21 buildings and related facilities for use as a law enforcement and

- 22 public safety facility and/or county jail facility. The authority
- 23 in this act shall extend to any infrastructure improvements and
- 24 access road improvements in connection with and a part of such
- 25 acquisition, maintenance, construction or equipping of the law
- 26 enforcement and public safety facility and/or county jail
- 27 facility.
- 28 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 29 and after its passage.
