HOUSE BILL NO. 1758

1 AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 912, LOCAL AND PRIVATE LAWS OF 2012, 2 TO INCREASE FROM \$200,000.00 TO \$350,000.00 THE PORTION OF THE OIL 3 AND GAS SEVERANCE TAX REVENUE THAT THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF 4 JEFFERSON DAVIS COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, MAY EXPEND TO ASSIST IN 5 DEFRAYING THE COST OF GARBAGE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL; AND FOR 6 RELATED PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. Chapter 912, Local and Private Laws of 2012, is
amended:

10 Section 1. The Board of Supervisors of Jefferson Davis 11 County, Mississippi, is authorized and empowered, in its discretion, to expend an amount not to exceed * * * Three Hundred 12 13 Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$350,000.00) of the oil and gas severance 14 tax revenue distributed to the county pursuant to Sections 15 27-25-505 and 27-25-705, Mississippi Code of 1972, to assist in defraying the cost of garbage collection and disposal in the 16 17 county.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 19 and after its passage.
