4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is authorized and approved for expenditure out of any
7	funds which are received by or otherwise become available to the
8	Mississippi State Port Authority at Gulfport, for the purpose of
9	defraying the expenses of the authority for the fiscal year
LO	beginning July 1, 2024, and ending June 30, 2025

L2	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
L3	Section 1, the following positions are authorized:

L 5	Permanent: 37
L 6	Time-Limited: 0
L 7	Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
L 8	the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

- 23 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 24 Mississippi State Port Authority at Gulfport shall maintain
- complete accounting and personnel records related to the 25
- 26 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such
- 27 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as
- maintained for Fiscal Year 2024. It is further the intention of 28

- 46 **SECTION 6.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 47 Mississippi State Port Authority at Gulfport shall only expend
- 48 funds on activities directly related to the operation of the state
- 49 port.
- 50 **SECTION 7.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 51 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with
- 52 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency
- 53 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their
- 54 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally
- or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for
- 56 actions contrary to this provision.
- 57 **SECTION 8.** The money appropriated under the provisions of
- 58 Section 1 shall be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper
- 59 person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 60 **SECTION 9.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 61 and after July 1, 2024, and shall stand repealed June 30, 2024.
