## HOUSE BILL NO. 1786 (As Sent to Governor)

1 2 3	AN ACT APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE OF SPECIAL FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE PEARL RIVER VALLEY WATER SUPPLY DISTRICT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2025.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is authorized and approved for expenditure out of any
7	special source funds which are received by or otherwise become
8	available to the Pearl River Valley Water Supply District, for the
9	purpose of defraying the expenses of the district for the fiscal
10	year beginning July 1, 2024, and ending June 30, 2025
11	\$ 25,191,367.00.
12	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
13	Section 1, the following positions are authorized:
14	AUTHORIZED HEADCOUNT:
15	Permanent: 109
16	Time-Limited: 1
17	With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's
18	responsibility to make certain that funds required for Personal

- 19 Services for Fiscal Year 2026 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2025 funds
- 20 appropriated for that purpose unless programs or positions are
- 21 added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2025 budget by the Mississippi
- 22 Legislature. The Legislature shall determine the agency's
- 23 personal services appropriation, which the State Personnel Board
- 24 shall publish. The agency's personal services appropriation may
- 25 consist of restricted funds for approved vacancies for Fiscal Year
- 26 2025 that may be utilized to fill vacant Fiscal Year 2024
- 27 headcount. It shall be the agency's responsibility to ensure that
- 28 the funds provided for vacancies are used to increase headcount
- 29 and not for promotions, title changes, in-range salary adjustments
- 30 or any other mechanism for increasing salaries for current
- 31 employees. It is the Legislature's intention that no employee
- 32 salary falls below the minimum salary established by the
- 33 Mississippi State Personnel Board.
- 34 Additionally, the State Personnel Board shall determine and
- 35 publish the projected annualized payroll costs based on current
- 36 employees. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to
- 37 ensure that actual personnel expenditures for Fiscal Year 2025 do
- 38 not exceed the data provided by the Legislative Budget Office. If
- 39 the agency's Fiscal Year 2025 projected cost exceeds the
- 40 annualized costs, no salary actions shall be processed by the
- 41 State Personnel Board except for new hires determined to be
- 42 essential for the agency.

43	Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
44	the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law or
45	allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
46	Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
47	approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
48	Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
49	approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
50	without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
51	appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in violation of the Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.

SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Pearl River Valley Water Supply District shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2024. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2026 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format

- 70 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 71 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 72 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things

- 74 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 75 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 76 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 77 made without competitive bids.
- 78 **SECTION 5.** The funds herein approved for expenditure, except
- 79 and less an amount approved by the State Fiscal Officer which
- 80 shall be sufficient to cover disbursements for current operations,
- 81 shall be deposited at interest with any official depository of the
- 82 state at a rate of interest numerically not less than one percent
- 83 (1%) below the bank discount rate on United States Treasury bills
- 84 of comparable maturity as determined by the State Treasurer.
- 85 **SECTION 6.** None of the funds appropriated for expenditure
- 86 under this act may be expended by Pearl River Valley Water Supply
- 87 District until the district agrees to comply with the following
- 88 condition: the District shall waive traffic control fees for any
- 89 vehicle displaying a "REZ" tag.
- 90 **SECTION 7.** None of the funds appropriated for expenditure
- 91 under this act may be expended by Pearl River Valley Water Supply
- 92 District until the district agrees to comply with the following

SECTION 9. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Section 1, One Million Seven Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars

(\$1,750,000.00), or so much thereof, shall be derived out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the Capital Expense Fund, as created in Section 27-103-303, Mississippi Code of 1972, and allocated in a manner as determined by the Treasurer's Office.

140	SECTION 12. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions
141	of Section 1 of this act, Four Million Dollars (\$4,000,000.00) is
142	provided for the construction of a new office building.

143	SECTION 13. The funds herein appropriated shall be expended
144	in compliance with Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972,
145	that no state agency shall incur obligations or indebtedness in
146	excess of their appropriation and that the responsible officers,
147	either personally or upon their official bonds, shall be held
148	responsible for actions contrary to this provision.
149	SECTION 14. The money herein approved for expenditure shall
150	be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper person, office
151	or officers, in the manner provided by law or in accordance with
152	the provisions of a valid trust indenture.
153	SECTION 15. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
154	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
155	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
156	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
157	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
158	proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law
159	SECTION 16. This act shall take effect and be in force from
160	and after July 1, 2024.
