HOUSE BILL NO. 1792

1 AN ACT APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE OF SPECIAL FUNDS FOR THE 2 PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE YELLOW CREEK STATE INLAND 3 PORT AUTHORITY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2025. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is authorized and approved for expenditure out of any 6 funds which are received by or otherwise become available to the 7 8 Yellow Creek State Inland Port Authority, for the purpose of 9 defraying the expenses of the Authority for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024, and ending June 30, 2025..... 10 11\$ 12,012,746.00. 12 SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Section 1, the following positions are authorized: 13 14 AUTHORIZED HEADCOUNT: 15 15 Permanent: 0 16 Time-Limited: Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 17 18 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

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No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 23 24 Yellow Creek State Inland Port Authority shall maintain complete accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all 25 26 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be 27 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2024. It is further the intention of the Legislature that 28 29 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2026 shall be 30 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 31 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 32 provided during the Fiscal Year 2025 budget request process.

33 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that 34 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 35 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 36 37 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 38 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 39 40 made without competitive bids.

41 SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated herein, Fifty Thousand 42 Dollars (\$50,000.00) is provided for salary increase for the 43 purpose of funding overtime, callback or standby pay.

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44 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 45 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with 46 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency 47 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their 48 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally 49 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for 50 actions contrary to this provision.

51 SECTION 7. The money herein approved for expenditure shall 52 be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper person, officer 53 or officers, in the manner provided by law.

54 SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from 55 and after July 1, 2024, and shall stand repealed June 30, 2024.
