HOUSE BILL NO. 1816
(As Passed the House)

1 AN ACT MAKING A REAPPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE
2 AND ADMINISTRATION TO REAUTHORIZE THE EXPENDITURE OF CAPITAL
3 EXPENSES AND SPECIAL FUNDS PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED FOR
4 CONSTRUCTION AND/OR REPAIR AND RENOVATION PROJECTS AT VARIOUS
5 STATE AGENCIES AND INSTITUTIONS, FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

7 **SECTION 1.** The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
8 necessary, is reappropriated out of any money in the State
9 Treasury to the credit of Fund No. 3393100000 to the Department of
10 Finance and Administration, acting through the Bureau of Building,
11 Grounds and Real Property Management, for the purpose of
12 reauthorizing the expenditure of funds previously appropriated for
13 construction and/or repair and renovation projects at various
14 state agencies and institutions, as authorized in HB No. 1643,
15 2023 Regular Session, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024,
16 and ending June 30, 2025.....\$ 59,856,026.00.

17 This reappropriation is made for the purpose of reauthorizing
18 the expenditure of special funds for construction and/or repair



19 and renovation projects at various state agencies and institutions
20 that had been authorized by the Legislature in prior fiscal years.

21 Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under this section,
22 the amount that may be expended under the authority of this
23 section shall not exceed the unexpended balance of the funds

377 This reappropriation is made for the purpose of reauthorizing
378 the expenditure of special funds for construction and/or repair
379 and renovation projects at various state agencies and institutions
380 that had been authorized by the Legislature in prior fiscal years.

381 Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under this section,
382 the amount that may be expended under the authority of this
383 section shall not exceed the unexpended balance of the funds
384 remaining as of June 30, 2024, from the amount authorized for the
385 previous fiscal year. In addition, this reappropriation shall not
386 change the purpose for which the funds were originally authorized.

387 **SECTION 20.** The Bureau of Building, Grounds and Real
388 Property Management of the Office of General Services is expressly



389 authorized and empowered to receive, budget and expend any state,
390 local or other source funds designated for supplemental funding of
391 construction and/or repair and renovation projects.

392 **SECTION 21.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
393 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
394 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
395 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
396 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
397 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

398 **SECTION 22.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
399 and after July 1, 2024.
