HOUSE BILL NO. 1821

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM SPECIAL FUNDS IN THE 2 STATE TREASURY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE 3 VETERANS' HOME PURCHASE BOARD AND MAKING NEW HOME LOANS AS 4 AUTHORIZED BY LAW FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2025. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 6 7 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 8 Treasury to the credit of the Veterans' Home Purchase Board's 9 revolving fund, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the 10 Veterans' Home Purchase Board and making new home loans as authorized by law for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024, and 11 12 ending June 30, 2025.....\$ 74,607,732.00. SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 13 14 Section 1, the following positions are authorized: 15 AUTHORIZED HEADCOUNT: 19 16 Permanent: 17 Time-Limited: 0 With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's 18 19 responsibility to make certain that funds required for Personal H. 20 Services for Fiscal Year 2026 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2025 funds 21 appropriated for that purpose unless programs or positions are 22 added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2025 budget by the Mississippi 23 Legislature. The Legislature shall determine the agency's personal 24 services appropriation, which the State Personnel Board shall 25 publish. In accordance with applicable laws, if an agency 26 determines that its personal services amount is insufficient, the 27 agency must contact the State Personnel Board. Any adjustment to 28 the personal services amount must be approved by the State 29 Personnel Director and the State Fiscal Officer after consultation 30 with the Legislative Budget Office. Any adjustment shall be reported to the Legislative Budget Office and the House and Senate 31 32 Appropriations Chairmen. The agency's personal services 33 appropriation may consist of restricted funds for approved vacancies for Fiscal Year 2025 that may not be utilized for active 34 35 Fiscal Year 2024 headcount. It shall be the agency's 36 responsibility to ensure that the funds provided for vacancies are used to increase headcount and not for promotions, title changes, 37 38 in-range salary adjustments, or any other mechanism for increasing 39 salaries for current employees. If the State Personnel Board 40 determines that an agency has used provided vacancy funds for any of the mechanisms previously listed, the State Personnel Board 41 shall not process any additional salary actions for the agency in 42 43 the current fiscal year, except for new hires determined by the State Personnel Board to be essential for the agency. It is the 44

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45 Legislature's intention that no employee salary falls below the 46 minimum salary established by the Mississippi State Personnel 47 Board.

Additionally, the State Personnel Board shall determine and 48 49 publish the projected annualized payroll costs based on current 50 employees. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to ensure that actual personnel expenditures for Fiscal Year 2025 do 51 52 not exceed the data provided by the Legislative Budget Office. If 53 the agency's projected cost for Fiscal Year 2025 exceeds the 54 annualized costs, no salary actions shall be processed by the 55 State Personnel Board except for new hires determined to be 56 essential for the agency.

57 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law or 58 59 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 60 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 61 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 62 63 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 64 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 65 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

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None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in violation of the Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.

74 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 75 Veterans' Home Purchase Board shall maintain complete accounting 76 and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds 77 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the 78 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 79 2024. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the 80 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2026 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 81 82 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 83 during the Fiscal Year 2025 budget request process.

SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that 84 85 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 86 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 87 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 88 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 89 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 90 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 91 made without competitive bids.

92 SECTION 5. The funds herein appropriated shall be expended 93 in compliance with Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, 94 that no state agency shall incur obligations or indebtedness in

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95 excess of their appropriation and that the responsible officers, 96 either personally or upon their official bonds, shall be held 97 responsible for actions contrary to this provision.

98 SECTION 6. The Veterans' Home Purchase Board is hereby 99 authorized to escalate, budget and expend funds from any source, 100 not to exceed Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000.00), for the 101 purpose of making new home loans as authorized by law, in 102 accordance with rules and regulations of the Department of Finance 103 and Administration in a manner consistent with the escalation of 104 federal funds.

105 SECTION 7. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 106 107 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 108 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 109 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 110 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 111 SECTION 8. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2024, and shall stand repealed June 30, 2024. 112
