HOUSE BILL NO. 1854

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF HARRISON 2 COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI, TO LEVY AN ASSESSMENT, IN ADDITION TO ANY 3 OTHER ASSESSMENTS AND COURT COSTS, FOR CONVICTIONS OBTAINED IN ITS JUSTICE, COUNTY AND CIRCUIT COURTS, TO BE USED TO FUND REPAIRS TO 4 5 AND RENOVATIONS OF THE COURTHOUSES AND PRETRIAL DETENTION 6 FACILITIES OF HARRISON COUNTY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 8 SECTION 1. (1) The Board of Supervisors of Harrison County, Mississippi, in its discretion, is authorized, by resolution duly 9 10 adopted, to levy an assessment, in addition to any other assessments and court costs, on convictions obtained in the 11 12 Justice Court, County Court and Circuit Court of Harrison County, 13 as follows: 14 (a) An amount not to exceed Twenty-five Dollars 15 (\$25.00) on each conviction obtained in the Justice Court, County 16 Court and Circuit Court of Harrison County, except for convictions for driving under the influence; and 17 18 (b) An amount not to exceed Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) on each conviction obtained for driving under the influence of 19 20 alcohol or any other substance which has impaired the person's H. 21 ability to operate a motor vehicle, pursuant to Section 63-11-30, 22 Mississippi Code of 1972.

(2) The avails of the additional assessment imposed under
subsection (1) of this section shall be expended by the Board of
Supervisors of Harrison County to fund repairs to and renovations
of the courthouses and pretrial detention facilities of Harrison
County.

(3) This section shall be repealed from and after July 1,29 2028.

30 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 31 and after its passage.
