HOUSE BILL NO. 4053

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO OMAR EUGENE MAGEE
2 OF COVINGTON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
5 completely restored to Omar Eugene Magee of Covington County,
6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his
7 conviction for the crime of grand larceny on May 25, 1978, in
8 Covington County, Mississippi, for which he was sentenced to serve
9 sixty (60) months in the custody of the Mississippi Department of
10 Corrections, released on probation and violated probation, was
11 convicted for the crime of grand larceny on December 15, 1978, in
12 Covington County, Mississippi, for which he was sentenced to serve
13 five (5) years; convicted for the crime of burglary on March 28,
14 1985, in Simpson County, Mississippi, for which he was sentenced
15 to serve three (3) years, released on June 20, 1986; convicted on
16 March 19, 1999, for two (2) counts of the crime of delivery of a
17 controlled substance to serve ten (10) years concurrently in the
18 custody of the Mississippi Department of Corrections.



19 He was discharged on September 12, 2008, due to expiration of
20 sentence. He completed all terms and conditions of his sentence.
21 The Legislature is informed that he has since conducted himself as
22 a law-abiding and honorable citizen in a good and lawful manner.

23 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
24 and after July 1, 2024.
