HOUSE BILL NO. 4078

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO CHANTY WILLIAMS OF  
2 COAHOMA COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and  
5 completely restored to Chanty Williams of Coahoma County,  
6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of her  
7 conviction for the crime of embezzlement on June 23, 2003, in  
8 Tunica County, Mississippi, for which she was sentenced to serve  
9 sixty (60) months under the supervision of the Mississippi  
10 Department of Corrections.

11 She was discharged on June 23, 2008, due to expiration of her  
12 sentence. The Legislature is informed that she has since  
13 conducted herself as a law-abiding and honorable citizen in a good  
14 and lawful manner.

15 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
16 and after its passage.
