HOUSE BILL NO. 4078

- AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO CHANTY WILLIAMS OF COAHOMA COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
- 5 completely restored to Chanty Williams of Coahoma County,
- 6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of her
- 7 conviction for the crime of embezzlement on June 23, 2003, in
- 8 Tunica County, Mississippi, for which she was sentenced to serve
- 9 sixty (60) months under the supervision of the Mississippi
- 10 Department of Corrections.
- 11 She was discharged on June 23, 2008, due to expiration of her
- 12 sentence. The Legislature is informed that she has since
- 13 conducted herself as a law-abiding and honorable citizen in a good
- 14 and lawful manner.
- 15 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 16 and after its passage.
