HOUSE BILL NO. 4086

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO JOSEPH GREER OF
2 HINDS COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
5 completely restored to Joseph Greer of Hinds County, Mississippi,
6 who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his conviction
7 for the crime of forgery on June 4, 1993, in Hinds County,
8 Mississippi, for which he was sentenced to serve six months in the
9 custody of the Mississippi Department of Corrections. On November
10 9, 2000, he was convicted for the crime of grand larceny in Rankin
11 County, Mississippi, for which he was sentenced to six months
12 probation under the supervision of the Mississippi Department of
13 Corrections. On March 14, 2011, in Hinds County, Mississippi, he
14 was convicted for the crime of cocaine-possession, and was
15 sentenced to serve five years supervised probation under
16 Mississippi Department of Corrections.

17 He was discharged on March 14, 2016, due to expiration of
18 sentence. The Legislature is informed that he has since conducted



19 himself as a law-abiding and honorable citizen in a good and
20 lawful manner.

21 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
22 and after its passage.
