HOUSE BILL NO. 4102

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO JOSEPH EARL GREER  
2 OF HINDS COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and  
5 completely restored to Joseph Earl Greer of Hinds County,  
6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his  
7 conviction for the crime of forgery, in Hinds County, for which he  
8 was sentenced to serve six (6) months in the custody of the  
9 Mississippi Department of Corrections. He was released due to  
10 expiration of sentence on December 4, 1993. On November 9, 2000,  
11 in Rankin County, Mississippi, he was convicted for the crime of  
12 grand larceny, and sentenced to serve five (5) years on probation  
13 under the supervision of the Mississippi Department of  
14 Corrections. On March 14, 2011, in Hinds County, he was convicted  
15 of the crime of possession of cocaine and sentenced to serve five  
16 (5) years probation under the supervision of the Mississippi  
17 Department of Corrections.



18           He was discharged on March 14, 2016. The Legislature is  
19 informed that he has since conducted himself as a law-abiding and  
20 honorable citizen in a good and lawful manner.

21           **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
22 and after its passage.
