HOUSE BILL NO. 4106

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO JASON TERRELL  
2 CARTER OF MADISON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and  
5 completely restored to Jason Terrell Carter of Madison County,  
6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his  
7 conviction for the crime of armed robbery on April 14, 2005, in  
8 Madison County, for which he was sentenced to serve twenty (20)  
9 years on Counts II and III and ten (10) years on Count I under the  
10 custody of the Mississippi Department of Corrections, with count  
11 III running concurrently with the sentence imposed in Count I and  
12 II.

13 He was discharged on April 25, 2013. The Legislature is  
14 informed that he has since conducted himself as a law-abiding and  
15 honorable citizen in a good and lawful manner.

16 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
17 and after its passage.
