HOUSE BILL NO. 4106

- AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO JASON TERRELL CARTER OF MADISON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
- 5 completely restored to Jason Terrell Carter of Madison County,
- 6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his
- 7 conviction for the crime of armed robbery on April 14, 2005, in
- 8 Madison County, for which he was sentenced to serve twenty (20)
- 9 years on Counts II and III and ten (10) years on Count I under the
- 10 custody of the Mississippi Department of Corrections, with count
- 11 III running concurrently with the sentence imposed in Count I and
- 12 II.
- 13 He was discharged on April 25, 2013. The Legislature is
- 14 informed that he has since conducted himself as a law-abiding and
- 15 honorable citizen in a good and lawful manner.
- 16 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 17 and after its passage.
