HOUSE BILL NO. 4108

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO CHESTER ALLEN
2 BUTLER OF TIPPDAH COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
5 completely restored to Chester Allen Butler of Tippah County,
6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his
7 conviction for the crime of arson on February 8, 1996, in Tippah
8 County, Mississippi, for which he was sentenced to serve five (5)
9 years probation.

10 He was discharged on February 8, 2001, due to expiration of
11 sentence. The Legislature is informed that he has since conducted
12 himself as a law-abiding and honorable citizen in a good and
13 lawful manner.

14 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
15 and after its passage.
