HOUSE BILL NO. 4121

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO LASONDRA BOWLING  
2 OF RANKIN COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and  
5 completely restored to Lasondra Bowling of Rankin County,  
6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of her  
7 conviction for the crime of conspiracy to commit a crime in Rankin  
8 County on November 26, 2012, for which she was sentenced to serve  
9 five (5) years probation. On April 21, 2014, she was convicted in  
10 Rankin County for the crime of embezzlement, for which she was  
11 sentenced to serve five (5) years in the custody of the  
12 Mississippi Department of Corrections followed by five (5) years  
13 on probation. On April 29, 2014, she was sentenced for the crime  
14 of conspiracy to commit a crime for which she was sentenced to  
15 serve two (2) years in the custody of the Mississippi Department  
16 of Corrections followed by three (3) years, nine (9) months and  
17 one (1) day probation. She was released to parole on December 7,  
18 2015.



19 She was released to probation on October 10, 2017, and was  
20 discharged from probation on May 26, 2020. The Legislature is  
21 informed that she has since conducted herself as a law-abiding and  
22 honorable citizen in a good and lawful manner.

23 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
24 and after its passage.
