HOUSE BILL NO. 4123

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO SCOTTY ADAM
2 MCMAHAN OF COVINGTON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI; AND FOR RELATED
3 PURPOSES.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

5 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
6 completely restored to Scotty Adam McMahan of Covington County,
7 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his
8 conviction on October 3, 2003, in Simpson County, for the crime of
9 arson-residence in Simpson County, for which he was sentenced to
10 serve four (4) years probation under the supervision of the
11 Mississippi Department of Corrections. On June 19, 2009, he was
12 convicted for the crime of arson-residence for which he was
13 sentenced to serve five (5) years in the custody of the
14 Mississippi Department of Corrections.

15 He completed the terms and conditions of his conviction and
16 was discharged on July 1, 2011. The Legislature is informed that
17 he has since conducted himself as a law-abiding and honorable
18 citizen in a good and lawful manner.



19 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
20 and after its passage.
