HOUSE BILL NO. 4123
(As Passed the House)

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO SCOTTY ADAM
2 MCMAHAN OF COVINGTON COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI; TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF
3 SUFFRAGE TO MICHAEL GRAY OF PRENTISS COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI; AND FOR
4 RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
7 completely restored to Scotty Adam McMahan of Covington County,
8 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his
9 conviction on October 3, 2003, in Simpson County, for the crime of
10 arson-residence in Simpson County, for which he was sentenced to
11 serve four (4) years probation under the supervision of the
12 Mississippi Department of Corrections. He violated probation; and
13 it was revoked. On August 7, 2009, he was sentenced to term
14 served.

15 He completed the terms and conditions of his conviction and
16 was discharged on July 1, 2011. The Legislature is informed that
17 he has since conducted himself as a law-abiding and honorable
18 citizen in a good and lawful manner.



19 **SECTION 2.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
20 completely restored to Michael Gray of Prentiss County,
21 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his
22 conviction for the crime of burglary larceny-residential on
23 October 10, 2005, in Prentiss County, for which he was sentenced
24 to serve five (5) years under the supervision of the Mississippi
25 Department of Corrections. On July 31, 2007, he violated his
26 probation and it was revoked. He was released to Earned Release
27 Supervision on August 27, 2008.

28 He was discharged on November 23, 2008. The Legislature is
29 informed that he has since conducted himself as a law-abiding and
30 honorable citizen in a good and lawful manner.

31 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
32 and after its passage.
