HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 24

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION PROPOSING TO AMEND THE MISSISSIPPI CONSTITUTION OF 1890 BY CREATING A NEW SECTION ESTABLISHING THE RIGHT TO PERSONAL REPRODUCTIVE DECISIONS.

- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF
- 5 MISSISSIPPI, That the following amendment to the Mississippi
- 6 Constitution of 1890 is proposed to the qualified electors of the
- 7 state:
- 8 Amend the Mississippi Constitution of 1890 by adding a new
- 9 section to read as follows:
- 10 "Section . Every individual possesses a fundamental
- 11 right of privacy with respect to personal reproductive decisions,
- 12 which entails the right to make and effectuate decisions about all
- 13 matters relating to pregnancy, and the state is prohibited from
- 14 denying or interfering with a person's right to obtain an abortion
- 15 before viability of the fetus, or when the abortion is necessary
- 16 to protect the life or health of the person."
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this proposed amendment shall be
- 18 submitted by the Secretary of State to the qualified electors at

- an election to be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday of November 2024, as provided by Section 273 of the Constitution
- 21 and by general law.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the explanation of this proposed
- 23 amendment for the ballot shall read as follows: "This proposed
- 24 constitutional amendment states that every individual possesses a
- 25 fundamental right of privacy with respect to personal reproductive
- 26 decisions, and the state is prohibited from denying or interfering
- 27 with a person's right to obtain an abortion before viability of
- 28 the fetus, or when the abortion is necessary to protect the life
- 29 or health of the person."
