HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 39

- A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO SECTION 33, 241, MISSISSIPPI CONSTITUTION OF 1890, TO PROVIDE THAT A PERSON
- 3 WHO HAS BEEN CONVICTED OF EMBEZZLEMENT, IF THE VALUE AND/OR AMOUNT
- 4 INVOLVED IS \$5,000.00 OR MORE, SHALL NOT BE A QUALIFIED ELECTOR;
- 5 AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF
- 7 MISSISSIPPI, That the following amendment to the Mississippi
- 8 Constitution of 1890 is proposed to the qualified electors of the
- 9 state:
- 10 Amend Section 241, Mississippi Constitution of 1890, to read
- 11 as follows:
- 12 "Section 241. Every inhabitant of this state, except idiots
- 13 and insane persons, who is a citizen of the United States of
- 14 America, eighteen (18) years old and upward, who has been a
- 15 resident of this state for one (1) year, and for one (1) year in
- 16 the county in which he offers to vote, and for six (6) months in
- 17 the election precinct or in the incorporated city or town in which
- 18 he offers to vote, and who is duly registered as provided in this
- 19 article, and who has never been convicted of murder, rape,

- 20 bribery, theft, arson, obtaining money or goods under false
- 21 pretense, perjury, forgery, embezzlement, if the value and/or
- 22 amount involved is Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) or more, or
- 23 bigamy, is declared to be a qualified elector, except that he
- 24 shall be qualified to vote for President and Vice President of the
- 25 United States if he meets the requirements established by Congress
- 26 therefor and is otherwise a qualified elector."
- 27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this proposed amendment shall be
- 28 submitted by the Secretary of State to the qualified electors at
- 29 an election to be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday
- 30 of November 2024, as provided by Section 273 of the Constitution
- 31 and by general law.
- 32 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the explanation of this proposed
- 33 amendment for the ballot shall read as follows: "This proposed
- 34 constitutional amendment provides that a person who has been

- 35 convicted of embezzlement, if the value and/or amount involved is
- 36 \$5,000.00 or more, shall not be a qualified elector."
