- 4 WHEREAS, the existing Gulf LNG Terminal is fully operational
- 5 and employs 22 people, and it is located on the Port of Pascagoula
- 6 next door to the Chevron refinery; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Gulf LNG and Gulf Liquefaction are companies that
- 8 are owned by a holding company that is owned by Kinder Morgan,
- 9 Thunderbird, Zenith and Chatham; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the existing Gulf LNG Terminal was placed in service
- 11 in October 2011, at the time the industry was turning away from
- 12 the utilization of LNG imports; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Gulf LNG and Gulf Liquefaction filed for an export
- 14 project at the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) in
- 15 2015, and they have been in discussion with various off-takers but
- 16 have yet to sign any meaningful contracts with counterparties to
- 17 use the facility and thus have been unable to take FID; and

18	WHEREAS, the Gulf LNG Liquefaction Project will enjoy many							
19	advantages as a brownfield development, including the ability to							
20	use significant existing infrastructure, the typical construction							
21	risks are significantly minimized, the successful track record							
22	with environmental permitting, the high confidence in terminal							
23	operations and the favorable building environment in the Gulf of							
24	Mexico; and							
25	WHEREAS, the extension at the FERC is commensurate with what							
26	other proposed LNG projects have received from FERC, and Gulf							
27	LNG/GLLC already have their non-FTA DOE authorization that does							
28	not expire until 2026; and							
29	WHEREAS, the extension of the Gulf LNG Liquefaction Project							
30	would have a tremendously positive impact on the State of							
31	Mississippi, and would be a huge economic boom for Jackson County,							
32	Mississippi:							
33	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF							
34	REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE SENATE CONCURRING							
35	THEREIN, That we urge the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission to							
36	extend the authorization for the Gulf LNG Liquefaction Project.
