HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 31

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING LOGAN AARON BUTLER
2 ON ACHIEVING THE HONOR OF EAGLE SCOUT BY THE BOY SCOUTS OF
3 AMERICA, TROOP 3 OF PETAL, MISSISSIPPI.

4 WHEREAS, Logan Aaron Butler, of Petal, Mississippi, and the
5 son of Janice and Shawn Butler was honored with the Eagle Scout
6 Award on Saturday, September 16, 2023, during the distinguished
7 and time-honored Eagle Court of Honor ceremony; and

8 WHEREAS, a member of Troop 3, Logan first joined the Boy
9 Scouts on September 10, 2012, and as evidenced by the truly
10 remarkable feat of receiving the Eagle Scout Award, his list of
11 community service and extracurricular activities highlight those
12 achievements and serve as an indicative forecast of the bright
13 future that lies ahead for this extraordinary young Mississippian;

15 WHEREAS, throughout his nearly 12 years as a Boy Scout, Logan
16 has fulfilled his duties and obligations of maintaining and
17 promoting the mission and vision of the Boy Scouts of America,



18 which placed him on the trajectory to accomplishing the services
19 and tasks necessary to achieve the rank of Eagle Scout; and

20 WHEREAS, Logan's Eagle Scout promotion was earned by
21 planning, developing and constructing his Eagle Scout service
22 project, which involved the construction of a mobile Lego Therapy
23 Cart, working to ensure the project would be highly beneficial for
24 the pediatric patients and students upon its completion on March
25 14, 2023, before participating in the Unit Leadership Conference
26 on October 23, 2023; and

27 WHEREAS, Logan has held his leadership positions within his
28 platoon as a Quartermaster and as a Senior Patrol leader,
29 respectively for eight months each, having received his Life Rank
30 on November 28, 2022; and

31 WHEREAS, an exemplar of citizenship and paying forward the
32 generous acts of kindness for those who have served his community
33 and the country, Logan is an individual of distinguishing refined
34 character, whose reputation precedes him and whose presence
35 establishes itself as a mainstay in any setting; and

36 WHEREAS, Logan is a bright, gracious young man who has strong
37 Christian beliefs and sets a positive example for those around
38 him, as an Eagle Scout is supposed to, and because of his great
39 interest in the world around him and making it the best he can, he
40 will ultimately become a great asset not just for the State of
41 Mississippi, but also for the nation as a whole; and

43 recognize and honor the best and brightest of Mississippi's youth,
44 especially those such as Logan Aaron Butler, who has attained
45 Scouting's highest rank by demonstrating the determination to
