- 13 Waterloo, Iowa, of the Wapsipinicon Area Council, under the
- 14 leadership of scoutmaster James Lincoln Page, a World War I
- 15 veteran, who organized the first all-Black Boy Scout Troops, which
- 16 were Troops 9 and 10, on February 10, 1925; and
- 17 WHEREAS, the title of Eagle Scout is the highest rank
- 18 attainable in the scouting program of the Boy Scouts of America

- 19 (BSA), awarded to any boy scout who has earned 21 merit badges and
- 20 demonstrated Scout Spirit through the Boy Scout Oath and Law,
- 21 service and leadership, which include an execution of an extensive
- 22 service project that the scout plans, organizes, leads and
- 23 manages; and
- 24 WHEREAS, completion of these important community projects are
- 25 used to assess the scout's demonstration of leadership and
- 26 commitment to duty, and often benefit religious institutions,
- 27 schools and the community, without inuring the benefit of the Boy
- 28 Scouts or be of a commercial nature; and
- 29 WHEREAS, Eagle Scouts are presented with a medal and a badge
- 30 that visibly recognizes the accomplishments of the scout, and
- 31 additional recognition can be earned through Eagle Palms, awarded
- 32 for completing additional tenure, leadership, and merit badge
- 33 requirements; and
- 34 WHEREAS, Mical Cook has fulfilled his duties and obligations
- 35 of maintaining and promoting the mission and vision of the Boy
- 36 Scouts of America by earning the required 21 merit badges, while
- 37 maintaining "B" academic honors as a senior at West Jones High
- 38 School; and
- 39 WHEREAS, a stand out scholar-athlete who is a member of the
- 40 West Jones football team, Mical's church, Old Palestine Missionary
- 41 Baptist Church, is a constant source of encouragement, and
- 42 reinforces the achievements and accomplishments of this young
