HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 64

1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE HARTFIELD  
2 ACADEMY SOFTBALL TEAM AND HEAD COACH BROOKE GORDON UPON WINNING  
3 THE MISSISSIPPI ASSOCIATION OF INDEPENDENT SCHOOLS SOFTBALL STATE  
4 CHAMPIONSHIP.

5 WHEREAS, the 2022-2023 Hartfield Academy Softball Team  
6 clinched a well-deserved victory when they swept through the  
7 Mississippi Association of Independent Schools (MAIS) State  
8 Tournament undefeated seven-game streak to win the 2023 MAIS State  
9 Softball Championship after erasing a five-run deficit in the  
10 final game of the three-game series against Jackson Prep; and
