A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING JAKE MOFFITT,

2 RESPECTFULLY KNOWN AS "MOFFITT THE MEDALIST" UPON WINNING 3 BACK-TO-BACK STATE GOLF MEDALIST HONORS IN THE MISSISSIPPI HIGH 4 SCHOOL ACTIVITIES ASSOCIATION (MHSAA) CLASS 4A STATE GOLF 5 CHAMPIONSHIPS AS A SOPHOMORE AND A JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT. 6 WHEREAS, proving that hard work and diligence are the keys to 7 success, Jake Moffitt, a junior high school student at Ripley High School, has affectionately and reverently earned the title 8 "Moffit the Medalist" because of his stellar golf skills and 10 impressive winning record; and WHEREAS, Jake has not only led his high school golf team to 11 12 consecutive championship titles back-to-back, but he also earned back-to-back medalist honors; and 13 WHEREAS, his second medalist honor title was earned with an 14 15 overall best of 176, by shooting a 71 in the opening round and a 76 over the final 18 holes; and 16 17 WHEREAS, currently a junior at Ripley High School, he has led

the varsity golf team to its second straight boys golf title by

- 20 Philadelphia; and
- 21 WHEREAS, just five months earlier in May when Jake was a
- 22 sophomore, he led the golf team to win its first 2023 Class 4A
- 23 State championship title which was held at the Pontotoc Country
- 24 Club; and
- 25 WHEREAS, as a result of his leadership play, Ripley High
- 26 School's golf team has now earned an unprecedented win of two
- 27 state titles within one calendar year; and
- 28 WHEREAS, Jake is also known as a "Leader in the Clubhouse"
- 29 because he has won a majority of the twelve golf tournaments that
- 30 Ripley High School has played in before the team's state
- 31 tournament win; and
- 32 WHEREAS, during these back-to-back wins, Jake was the one
- 33 consistent as the team's first win was superbly coached by Chad
- 34 Brown, and the second win was excellently coached by Nik Wilcher;
- 35 and
- 36 WHEREAS, Coach Wilcher admires Jake's skills and takes no
- 37 credit for the player he is, Coach Wilcher believes Jake is "still
- 38 one of the best golfers in the state" even when he is not on top
- 39 of his game; and
- 40 WHEREAS, described as one of the Magnolia state's best junior
- 41 golfers, he is preparing to compete in the Notah Begay III Junior
- 42 Golf National Championships in Kinder, Louisiana in November; and

45	skill while bringing honor to their schools and families:
