 UPON A SUCCESSFUL BASKETBALL SEASON AND BEING NAMED THE 2024
 SOUTHWESTERN ATHLETIC CONFERENCE'S (SWAC) WOMEN'S DEFENSIVE PLAYER
 OF THE YEAR.

5 WHEREAS, Ms. Angel Jackson continues to reign supreme as she 6 has once again ascended to pinnacle of basketball excellence, upon 7 the distinguished honor of being named the Southwestern Athletic 8 Conference's (SWAC) Women's Defensive Player of the Year for the 9 second time in her collegiate career of play at Jackson State 10 University; and

11 WHEREAS, Ms. Jackson achieved this truly astonishing feat, 12 after another electric season with the Jackson State University 13 Lady Tigers Basketball Team, which culminated in the Lady Tigers 14 clenching its third SWAC Championship title in three years and its 15 third berth to the NCAA Tournament; and

16 WHEREAS, nationally ranked in multiple categories, Ms.
17 Jackson, the reigning Preseason Defensive Player of the Year,
18 finished the season ranked No. 10 in the nation in blocked shots

19 and 13th in blocks after making 26 game appearances, and starting 20 in every single one of those matchups; and

21 WHEREAS, with 71 blocked shots on the season, Ms. Jackson led 22 the Tigers and the SWAC with a No. 1 ranking in blocked shots, 23 while finishing ninth in the SWAC in rebounding, leading JSU with 24 a game average of 6.6 rebounds per game, which also positioned her 25 to be tapped for selection to the SWAC Second Team All-Conference; 26 and

27 WHEREAS, Ms. Jackson averaged 9.5 points per game, which 28 catapulted her season scoring total to 247 points, with an 29 incredible 172 rebounds, as she honed in with an eagle-eye focus 30 of achieving the remarkable feat of a 1,000-career points 31 milestone; and

32 WHEREAS, having registered 12 double figure scoring games, 33 five double figure rebounding games this season and four 34 double-doubles, Jackson's grit and tenacity to not only play, but 35 to master both the grueling mental and physical demands of the 36 game allowed her to finish her collegiate career with an 37 awe-inspiring 1,047 points and 723 rebounds; and

38 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the House of Representatives to 39 recognize and commend extraordinary Mississippi student-athletes, 40 especially those such as Ms. Jackson, whose hard work and 41 dedication brings honor to the sport of women's basketball, 42 Jackson State University, and to the State of Mississippi:
