1 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE JEFFERSON 2 COUNTY HIGH SCHOOL TIGERS FOOTBALL TEAM AND HEAD COACH RODERICK 3 HOLMES FOR COMPLETING AN OUTSTANDING NINE-WIN SEASON AND CAPTURING THE MISSISSIPPI HIGH SCHOOL ACTIVITIES ASSOCIATION REGION 7 CLASS 5 3A DISTRICT CHAMPIONSHIP. 6 WHEREAS, the Jefferson County High School Tigers Football

- 7 Team persevered through a remarkably ferocious season, and with
- motivation and audacity, they successfully finished the 2023-2024 8
- season with a historic season that finished 9-4 and won the 9
- 10 Mississippi High School Activities Association (MHSAA) Region 7
- 11 Class 3A District Championship; and
- 12 WHEREAS, the Jefferson County High School Tigers Football
- Team achieved excellence on November 24, 2023, when they hosted 13
- the first ever Mississippi High School Activities Association 14
- 15 Class 3A South State Championship at Tiger Den Stadium in Fayette,
- 16 Mississippi; and
- 17 WHEREAS, in a season that will be remembered as one of the
- most exciting seasons in recent years, the Jefferson County High 18
- 19 School Tigers cemented the team's place in the football history

- 20 books with the most wins in a season with nine, the most points
- 21 scored in a game at 83, the most points scored in a season at 457,
- 22 most points both teams in a game at 113, and back-to-back MHSAA
- 23 Region 7 Class 3A District Championships; and
- 24 WHEREAS, throughout their season of play, the Tigers faced
- 25 off with some of the state's best contenders on the gridiron but
- 26 persevered to make their presence and talent known as gladiators
- 27 of football under the Friday night lights; and
- 28 WHEREAS, the Tigers were led by quarterback Jabari Watson,
- 29 athlete Royale Shelvy, linebacker Jamarion Claiborne, linebacker
- 30 Jermall Williams, and defensive back De'Anthony Miller; and
- 31 WHEREAS, the Tigers' offense would have been grounded without
- 32 the speed and agility of the wide receivers; the running backs,
- 33 who left it all on the field to dominate their hostile foes; the
- 34 offensive linemen that held off each rival's defense with their
- 35 potency and concentration and allowed the Tigers to set new school
- 36 records in scoring; the tight ends, whose versatility made the
- 37 nine victories possible; the fullbacks, constantly playing with
- 38 clear eyes, full hearts, and unimaginable amounts of strength; and
- 39 the quarterback, who handled the ball with accuracy, consistency
- 40 and vivacity; and
- 41 WHEREAS, the Tigers were unparalleled on defense, which was
- 42 commanded by the fierce and powerful defensive backs, the
- 43 linebackers, overflowing with strength and tenacity, the defensive
- 44 linemen, whose grind, fortitude and determination erected a stone

- 45 wall that helped secure each of Jefferson County's nine victories,
- 46 the defensive ends, whose tackles and sacks were fierce and will
- 47 not soon be forgotten by the opponents they met, and the safeties
- 48 and cornerbacks, while bursting with wit and athleticism, duped
- 49 more than one quarterback this season and defended long passes
- 50 with ease; and
- 51 WHEREAS, the kickers and long snappers and others on special
- 52 teams were a huge asset to the Tigers' excellent season, as they
- 53 brought more than one game out of the clutches of defeat and into
- 54 the hands of victory; and
- 55 WHEREAS, the Jefferson County High School Football Team has
- 56 been superbly coached and inspired by Head Coach Roderick Holmes,
- 57 who has broadened the Tigers' knowledge of the game and refined
- 58 their skills in execution; and
- 59 WHEREAS, the team's success would not have been possible
- 60 without the talented coaching staff, including Kiwaski Tenner,
- 61 Bouvier Ellis, Zackery Berry, Stacey Murphy, Joshua Lutch, Anthony
- 62 Williams and Rah'Kendrick Reynolds as well as the administrative
- 63 personnel, including Dr. Larondrial Barnes, Kimberly Walker-King
- 64 and Marcus Walton; and
- 65 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the House of Representatives to
- 66 recognize and honor the achievements of student-athletes such as
- 67 the Jefferson County High School Tigers Football Team who have
- 68 brought honor to their school, their community, and to the State
