- 20 WHEREAS, SFC Williams joined the Mississippi Army National
- 21 Guard and re-classed to a Chemical NCO at the 198th CAV Regiment
- 22 in Booneville, Mississippi, and in 2018, he accepted a Recruiting
- 23 and Retention position where he has made or exceeded his yearly
- 24 milestone every year; and
- 25 WHEREAS, in RY 19, SFC Williams was awarded Rookie of the
- 26 Year, and successfully enlisted 22 soldiers into the Mississippi
- 27 Army National Guard, and that same year, he graduated from a very
- 28 tough 74D Advanced Leaders Course in which he was awarded Honor
- 29 Graduate; and
- 30 WHEREAS, in RY 21, SFC Williams graduated from 79T Senior
- 31 Leaders Course and was again awarded Honor Graduate, and in RY 22,
