- 6 SECTION 1. (1) A person who knowingly, willfully and
- 7 maliciously makes a false report of abuse, abandonment, or neglect
- 8 of a child, or a person who, with malice, counsels another to make
- 9 a false report, may be civilly liable for damages suffered by the
- 10 subject of the report, including reasonable attorney fees and
- 11 costs, as a result of the filing of the false report.
- 12 (2) A report is false under this section if no rational
- 13 argument can be advanced in its support, when it is unsupported by
- 14 any credible evidence, when a reasonable person could not have
- 15 expected its success or when it is completely untenable.
- 16 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 17 and after July 1, 2024.
