- AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT ALL FEDERAL ACTS, LAWS, ORDERS, RULES AND REGULATIONS, WHETHER PAST, PRESENT OR FUTURE, WHICH HINDER OR 3 PROHIBIT THE SALE, DISTRIBUTION, LICENSING, POSSESSION OR
- INSTALLATION OF GAS STOVES SHALL BE INVALID IN THIS STATE; TO
- DEFINE THE TERM "GAS STOVE"; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 SECTION 1. (1) All federal acts, laws, orders, rules and
- 8 regulations, whether past, present or future, which hinder or
- prohibit the sale, distribution, licensing, possession or
- 10 installation of gas stoves shall be invalid in this state, shall
- not be recognized by this state, shall be specifically rejected by 11
- this state and have no effect in this state. 12
- 13 (2) Such federal acts, laws, orders, rules and regulations
- 14 include any act prohibiting the possession of gas stoves.
- 15 (3) No public officer or employee of this state shall have
- 16 any authority to enforce or attempt to enforce any of the
- 17 infringements on the possession of gas stoves.

- 18 (4) As used in this section, "gas stove" shall mean a
 19 cooking appliance that consists of burners and an oven fueled by
 20 either natural gas or propane gas.
- 21 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 22 and after July 1, 2024.
