SENATE BILL NO. 2266

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 9-1-59, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO  
2 PROVIDE THAT PUBLIC DEFENDERS SHALL HAVE FREE ACCESS TO THE  
3 MISSISSIPPI ELECTRONIC COURT SYSTEM RECORDS FOR MATTERS INVOLVING  
4 INDIGENT DEFENDANTS; TO BRING FORWARD SECTION 99-19-73,  
5 MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, FOR PURPOSES OF POSSIBLE AMENDMENT; AND  
6 FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

8 **SECTION 1.** Section 9-1-59, Mississippi Code of 1972, is  
9 amended as follows:

10 9-1-59. (1) Each circuit, chancery and county court in this  
11 state shall require all pleadings and other papers to be served,  
12 filed, signed or verified by electronic means in conformity with  
13 the Mississippi Electronic Court System procedures by July 1,  
14 2021.

15 (2) Public defenders shall have free access to the  
16 Mississippi Electronic Court System records for matters involving  
17 indigent defendants.

18 **SECTION 2.** Section 99-19-73, Mississippi Code of 1972, is  
19 brought forward as follows:



20 99-19-73. (1) **Traffic violations.** In addition to any  
21 monetary penalties and any other penalties imposed by law, there  
22 shall be imposed and collected the following state assessment from  
23 each person upon whom a court imposes a fine or other penalty for  
24 any violation in Title 63, Mississippi Code of 1972, except  
25 offenses relating to the Mississippi Implied Consent Law (Section  
26 63-11-1 et seq.) and offenses relating to vehicular parking or  
27 registration:

133 (5) **Speeding, reckless and careless driving violations.** In  
 134 addition to any assessment imposed under subsection (1) or (2) of  
 135 this section, there shall be imposed and collected the following  
 136 state assessment from each person upon whom a court imposes a fine  
 137 or other penalty for driving a vehicle on a road or highway:

138 (a) At a speed that exceeds the posted speed limit by  
 139 at least ten (10) miles per hour but not more than twenty (20)  
 140 miles per hour.....\$10.00

141 (b) At a speed that exceeds the posted speed limit by  
 142 at least twenty (20) miles per hour but not more than thirty (30)  
 143 miles per hour.....\$20.00



144 (c) At a speed that exceeds the posted speed limit by  
145 thirty (30) miles per hour or more.....\$30.00

146 (d) In violation of Section 63-3-1201, which is the  
147 offense of reckless driving.....\$10.00

148 (e) In violation of Section 63-3-1213, which is the  
149 offense of careless driving.....\$10.00

150 All assessments collected under this subsection shall be  
151 deposited into the State General Fund.

152 (6) **Other misdemeanors.** In addition to any monetary  
153 penalties and any other penalties imposed by law, there shall be  
154 imposed and collected the following state assessment from each  
155 person upon whom a court imposes a fine or other penalty for any  
156 misdemeanor violation not specified in subsection (1), (2) or (3)  
157 of this section, except offenses relating to vehicular parking or  
158 registration:

229 (a) **Railroad crossing violations.** In addition to any  
 230 monetary penalties and any other penalties imposed by law, there  
 231 shall be imposed and collected the following state assessment in  
 232 addition to all other state assessments due under this section  
 233 from each person upon whom a court imposes a fine or other penalty  
 234 for any violation involving railroad crossings under Section  
 235 37-41-55, 63-3-1007, 63-3-1009, 63-3-1011, 63-3-1013 or 77-9-249:

236 Operation Lifesaver Fund.....\$25.00

237 (b) **Drug violations.** In addition to any monetary  
 238 penalties and any other penalties imposed by law, there shall be  
 239 imposed and collected the following state assessment in addition  
 240 to all other state assessments due under this section from each  
 241 person upon whom a court imposes a fine or other penalty for any  
 242 violation of Section 41-29-139:

245 (c) **Motor vehicle liability insurance violations.** In  
246 addition to any monetary penalties and any other penalties imposed  
247 by law, there shall be imposed and collected the following state  
248 assessment in addition to all other state assessments due under  
249 this section from each person upon whom a court imposes a fine or  
250 other penalty for any violation of Section 63-15-4(4) or Section  
251 63-16-13(1):

252 Uninsured Motorist Identification Fund:  
253 First offense.....\$200.00  
254 Second offense.....\$300.00  
255 Third or subsequent offense.....\$400.00

256 (9) If a fine or other penalty imposed is suspended, in  
257 whole or in part, such suspension shall not affect the state  
258 assessment under this section. No state assessment imposed under  
259 the provisions of this section may be suspended or reduced by the  
260 court.

261 (10) (a) After a determination by the court of the amount  
262 due, it shall be the duty of the clerk of the court to promptly  
263 collect all state assessments imposed under the provisions of this  
264 section. The state assessments imposed under the provisions of  
265 this section may not be paid by personal check.

266 (b) It shall be the duty of the chancery clerk of each  
267 county to deposit all state assessments collected in the circuit,



268 county and justice courts in the county on a monthly basis with  
269 the State Treasurer pursuant to appropriate procedures established  
270 by the State Auditor. The chancery clerk shall make a monthly  
271 lump-sum deposit of the total state assessments collected in the  
272 circuit, county and justice courts in the county under this  
273 section, and shall report to the Department of Finance and  
274 Administration the total number of violations under each  
275 subsection for which state assessments were collected in the  
276 circuit, county and justice courts in the county during that  
277 month.

278 (c) It shall be the duty of the municipal clerk of each  
279 municipality to deposit all the state assessments collected in the  
280 municipal court in the municipality on a monthly basis with the  
281 State Treasurer pursuant to appropriate procedures established by  
282 the State Auditor. The municipal clerk shall make a monthly  
283 lump-sum deposit of the total state assessments collected in the  
284 municipal court in the municipality under this section, and shall  
285 report to the Department of Finance and Administration the total  
286 number of violations under each subsection for which state  
287 assessments were collected in the municipal court in the  
288 municipality during that month.

289 (11) It shall be the duty of the Department of Finance and  
290 Administration to deposit on a monthly basis all state assessments  
291 into the State General Fund or proper special fund in the State  
292 Treasury. The Department of Finance and Administration shall



293 issue regulations providing for the proper allocation of these  
294 funds.

295 (12) The State Auditor shall establish by regulation  
296 procedures for refunds of state assessments, including refunds  
297 associated with assessments imposed before July 1, 1990, and  
298 refunds after appeals in which the defendant's conviction is  
299 reversed. The Auditor shall provide in the regulations for  
300 certification of eligibility for refunds and may require the  
301 defendant seeking a refund to submit a verified copy of a court  
302 order or abstract by which the defendant is entitled to a refund.  
303 All refunds of state assessments shall be made in accordance with  
304 the procedures established by the Auditor.

305 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
306 and after July 1, 2024.
