- 11 amended as follows:
- 12 37-13-8. (1) In each public school classroom, the local
- 13 school governing board * * * shall require a brief period of quiet
- 14 reflection for not more than sixty (60) seconds at the opening of
- 15 school upon every school day.
- 16 (2) The moment of quiet reflection * * * required by
- 17 subsection (1) of this section is not intended to be and shall not
- 18 be conducted as a religious service or exercise but is considered
- 19 an opportunity for a moment of silent reflection.

- 20 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 21 and after July 1, 2024.
