## SENATE BILL NO. 2343

	AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE MISSISSIPPI MODIFIED SCHOOL CALENDAR
2	GRANT PROGRAM TO BE ADMINISTERED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION
3	FOR THE PURPOSE OF INCENTIVIZING PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO
4	MAINTAIN OR CONSIDER ADOPTING A MODIFIED SCHOOL CALENDAR BY
5	OFFSETTING COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH ADOPTING A MODIFIED SCHOOL
6	CALENDAR THROUGH A TIME-LIMITED GRANT; TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT
7	TO DEVELOP REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES TO GOVERN THE ADMINISTRATION
8	OF THE GRANT PROGRAM, INCLUDING APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS; TO
9	PROVIDE FOR THE ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA; TO PROVIDE THAT GRANTS
10	AWARDED SHALL BE USED FOR EXPENSES INCURRED AS A RESULT OF THE
11	ADOPTION OF A MODIFIED SCHOOL CALENDAR; TO PROVIDE THAT SCHOOL
12	DISTRICTS SHALL BE ELIGIBLE FOR A MAXIMUM AWARD OF \$250,000.00 PER
13	YEAR FOR A MAXIMUM OF THREE YEARS; TO CREATE A SPECIAL FUND IN THE
14	STATE TREASURY, TO BE KNOWN AS THE "MISSISSIPPI MODIFIED SCHOOL
15	CALENDAR GRANT FUND"; TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT TO PROVIDE A
16	COMPREHENSIVE REPORT ON THE USE OF FUNDS DISTRIBUTED UNDER THIS
17	GRANT PROGRAM TO THE GOVERNOR, LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR, SPEAKER OF THE
18	HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, AND CHAIRS OF THE SENATE AND HOUSE
19	APPROPRIATIONS AND EDUCATION COMMITTEES BY OCTOBER 1, 2024, AND
20	OCTOBER 1 OF EACH YEAR THEREAFTER; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
21	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
22	<b>SECTION 1.</b> This act shall be known and may be cited as the
23	"Mississippi Modified School Calendar Grant Program."
24	<b>SECTION 2.</b> The Mississippi Legislature finds the following:
25	(a) Whereas, a modified school calendar apportioning
26	required instructional days throughout the year can increase

27 student achievement and engagement and provide staff with a	more

- 28 flexible schedule.
- 29 (b) Therefore, it is the intent of the Mississippi
- 30 Legislature to incentivize public school districts to maintain or
- 31 consider adopting a modified school calendar by offsetting costs
- 32 associated with adopting a modified school calendar through a
- 33 time-limited grant.
- 34 **SECTION 3.** For purposes of this act, the following words
- 35 shall have the meanings ascribed herein unless the context
- 36 requires otherwise:
- 37 (a) "Grant program" means the Mississippi Modified
- 38 School Calendar Grant Program established in this act.
- 39 (b) "Department" means the Mississippi Department of
- 40 Education.
- 41 (c) "Modified school calendar" means a nontraditional
- 42 school calendar in which the length of summer break is shortened,
- 43 there are breaks dispersed throughout the school year, and
- 44 required instructional days are evenly distributed across the
- 45 calendar year.
- 46 (d) "School district" means all public school
- 47 districts.
- 48 **SECTION 4.** (1) There is established the Mississippi
- 49 Modified School Calendar Grant Program which shall be administered
- 50 by the department for the purpose of offsetting initial costs

- 51 incurred by school districts which have implemented or intend to
- 52 implement a modified school calendar.
- 53 (2) Subject to the provisions of this act and any other
- 54 applicable state law and regulation, school districts receiving a
- 55 grant shall have the authority to use the funds provided in this
- 56 grant program in a way that best facilitates their plan to
- 57 transition to and maintain a modified school calendar and maximize
- 58 student achievement and engagement.
- 59 **SECTION 5.** (1) The department shall:
- 60 (a) Inform all school districts about the grant
- 61 program;
- (b) Develop regulations and procedures to govern the
- 63 administration of the grant program, including application
- 64 requirements, within two (2) months after enactment; and
- 65 (c) Subject to appropriation, award school districts
- 66 meeting the requirements of the program a grant for expenses
- 67 related to the adoption or maintenance of a modified school
- 68 calendar beginning in the 2024-2025 academic year. Initial grant
- 69 awards shall be made by July 1, 2024, and July 1 of each year
- 70 thereafter.
- 71 (2) The department shall administer this program with
- 72 existing personnel and resources and shall not contract for

- 73 external support.
- 74 (3) An application for an award from the grant program shall
- 75 include:

76 (	a)	The	rationale	for	adopting	а	modified	school

- 77 calendar, including relevant short- and long-term goals of the
- 78 school district, which a modified calendar may help achieve;
- 79 (b) Evidence of community support and engagement to
- 80 move to a modified school calendar;
- 81 (c) A detailed budget of operating expenses expected to
- 82 be incurred as a result of adopting a modified calendar; and
- 83 (d) A detailed calendar, including plans for any
- 84 intercession activities.
- 85 (4) Grants awarded shall be used for expenses incurred as a
- 86 result of the adoption of a modified school calendar, including,
- 87 but not limited to:
- 88 (a) Transportation;
- 89 (b) Certified and noncertified staffing during
- 90 intercessions;
- 91 (c) Remediation and enrichment programs during
- 92 intercession; and
- 93 (d) Utilities.
- 94 **SECTION 6.** (1) School districts shall be eligible for a
- 95 maximum award of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00)
- 96 per year for a maximum of three (3) years.
- 97 (2) Eliqible school districts shall include those which
- 98 implement a modified school calendar by the beginning of the
- 99 2024-2025 academic year. Any school district which implemented a

- 100 modified school calendar in the 2021-2022, 2022-2023, 2023-2024 or
  101 2024-2025 academic years shall also be eligible.
- 102 (3) The amount awarded each year shall be based on the
  103 actual budget and plan submitted by the school district, the
  104 number of students in the school district, and other factors which
  105 may increase the cost of delivery of services, including the rural
  106 nature of the school district.
- 107 (4) The amount of the award shall not exceed the actual
  108 budget submitted by the school district related to modified school
  109 calendar costs.
- 110 (5) Grants received by school districts under this chapter
  111 shall not be used to purchase land, construct new facilities or to
  112 finance or satisfy any existing debt.
- SECTION 7. There is created a special fund in the State 113 114 Treasury, to be known as the "Mississippi Modified School Calendar 115 Grant Fund," from which the grants authorized by this act shall be 116 disbursed by the department. The fund shall be maintained by the State Treasurer as a separate and special fund, separate and apart 117 118 from the General Fund of the state. Unexpended amounts remaining 119 in the fund at the end of a fiscal year shall remain in the fund 120 and shall not lapse into the State General Fund. Any interest 121 earned or investment earnings or interest earned on amounts in the fund shall be deposited to the credit of the fund. 122
- 123 **SECTION 8.** The department shall provide a comprehensive 124 report on the use of funds distributed under this grant program

- 130 **SECTION 9.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 131 and after its passage.
