SENATE BILL NO. 2356

1 AN ACT TO RESTORE THE RIGHT OF SUFFRAGE TO EDWARD CARTER,
2 SR., OF CLAIBORNE COUNTY, MISSISSIPPI.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

4 **SECTION 1.** The right of suffrage is hereby fully and
5 completely restored to Edward Carter, Sr., of Claiborne County,
6 Mississippi, who was disqualified as an elector as a result of his
7 conviction in 1998 of the crime of embezzlement in Claiborne
8 County, Mississippi, and who was sentenced to serve five (5) years
9 in the custody of the Department of Corrections with four (4)
10 years suspended and four (4) years on probation. He was released
11 on April 9, 1999, on expiration of sentence and placed on
12 probation, and was discharged on April 11, 2003. The Legislature
13 is informed that he has since conducted himself as a law-abiding
14 and honorable citizen in a good and lawful manner.

15 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
16 and after its passage.
