SENATE BILL NO. 2367

- AN ACT TO CREATE A NEW SECTION IN TITLE 23, CHAPTER 15,
- 2 ARTICLE 27, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROHIBIT RANKED-CHOICE
- 3 VOTING IN STATEWIDE, COUNTY, LOCAL, MUNICIPAL OR SCHOOL DISTRICT
- 4 ELECTIONS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** (1) Ranked-choice voting is prohibited in
- 7 statewide, county, local, municipal and school district elections
- 8 in the State of Mississippi.
- 9 (2) Any voting method that allows electors to rank
- 10 candidates for an office in order of preference and has ballots
- 11 cast that will be tabulated in multiple rounds following the
- 12 elimination of a candidate until a single candidate attains a
- 13 majority shall not be used in determining the election or
- 14 nomination of any candidate for elective office in this state,
- 15 including elective offices for any county, municipality, school
- 16 district, state or federal office.
- 17 (3) Any existing or future ordinance or policy enacted or
- 18 adopted by a county, municipality, school district, or any other

- 19 local governmental entity that conflicts with this section is void
- 20 on and after July 1, 2024.
- 21 (4) This section shall not apply to electors who are
- 22 entitled to vote absentee ballot under the federal Uniformed and
- 23 Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act, 52 USC Section 20301, et
- 24 seq., as amended.
- 25 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 26 and after July 1, 2024.
